The office is situated close to the centre of Utrecht and a ten-minute walk from Utrecht Central Station.



By public transport

Departing from Amsterdam:

Trains (directions either 's Hertogenbosch/Eindhoven/Maastricht or Arnhem/Nijmegen) leave every quarter of an hour from Amsterdam Central Station. It takes about half an hour to get to the city of Utrecht.

Arriving at Utrecht Central Station:

Go to the central hall (first floor). Choose one of the following options:

Taxi: Stay at this level if you want a taxi; you find them outside the entrance at your left hand side.

Bus: the bus station is on the ground level. Go down the stairs and take bus 1, 6 or 7 directions Overvecht or Zuilen (ask the driver, since one has to choose between busses with the same number, going in different directions!). Oudenoord is a 5-minute drive.

The bus stop (called 'Oudenoord') is opposite the office of World Population in the building of Rutgers Nisso Groep.

Walk: departing from the bus station (ground level), turn to your left, pass the level crossing of the tram to your right, walk straight on (passing traffic lights, a fly over and

the former Music Hall 'Vredenburg'. At the next traffic lights (Apollo Hotel on the right hand corner) turn to the left (St. Jacobsstraat) and walk for about 700 yards (passing three traffic lights and a bridge over canal). The office of Rutgers Nisso Groep is on your left.
