Our rights-based approach... unzipped!

There is lots of talking about rights-based approaches (RBA), but how it actually impacts organisations, policies and practices is often somehow blurred. During this plenary workshop the organisers of the conference - World Population Foundation and Youth Incentives - and 2 Dutch guest organisation will "go the full monty" on their ways of using a rights based approach in their work.

The aim of this workshop is to stimulate a lively debate of the practicalities of RBA and share opportunities, struggles, and strategies. This plenary session enables conference participants to probe Dutch Development Organisations on how they practice the rights-based approach. How does it, for example, affect partnerships, acquisition, programming and human resources policies?

With 4 Dutch development organisations on stage to reveal their rights-based mode of operation, it is ensured to keep the discussion on RBA applied and concrete. Therefore, this plenary session promises to be an interesting and critical debate where the Rights and Realities, and the realities of rights will be unzipped.
